★ Necessary Materials

- One 3-subject Spiral notebook and a color-coordinated folder  
OR  
Binder with 3 dividers
- Pencils with erasers (mechanical pencils are best)
- Scientific calculator

★ Grading

- **3-Subject Spiral and a Color-Coordinated Folder**
  - Label the sections Notes, Homework, and Other
- OR
- Don't label sections and follow the pattern {Notes, HW, Notes, HW, Notes, HW...}
- Keep loose papers in your color-coordinated folder
  
- **Binder**
  - Dividers should separate your notebook into the following 3 sections:
    1. **Notes and Classwork**
    2. **Homework**
    3. **Assessments**
  - All handouts should be hole-punched and filed into the correct section

★ **What should I write down each day?**

- **Notes** - Date, Aim, Do Now, and anything written or said during class
- **Homework** - Date, Period, Assignment, and Solutions

★ **What should I do if I am absent or forgetful?**
